CHECK list

Basic Essentials

- Leash and Harness:** A sturdy leash and a comfortable harness.
- Collar with ID Tags:** Ensure your dog's ID tags are up-to-date with contact information.
- Microchip Informations:** Verify that the microchip information is current.
- Towel:** For drying off after swims or rainy weather.
- Poop Bags:** Biodegradable bags for waste disposal.

Hydration and Nutrition

- Water:** Plenty of water and a portable water bottle.
- Food:** Sufficient dog food for the duration of the trip.
- Food and Water Bowls:** Collapsible food and water bowls for easy packing

Shelter and Bedding

- Tent:** Make sure the tent is spacious enough for you and your dog.
- Sleeping Bag:** A dog-specific sleeping bag or blanket for warmth.
- Dog Bed:** A portable dog bed or mat for comfort.

Safety and First Aid

- First Aid Kit:** Include bandages, antiseptic wipes, tweezers, and any necessary medications.
- Tick Removal Tools:** Essential for removing ticks
- Emergency Contact List:** Local vets and emergency services
- Dog-Safe Bug Spray:** To protect against insects.

Entertainment

- Toys:** Favorite toys to keep your dog entertained.
- Chew Toys:** Durable chew toys for downtime.

Navigation and Safety

- GPS Tracker:** A GPS tracker on your dog's collar.
- Reflective Gear:** Reflective vest or bands for visibility.
- Life Jacket:** If you'll be near water or going swimming.

Additional Gear

- Portable Fence:** To create a safe area for your dog to roam.
- Cooling Vest/Bandana:** To keep your dog cool in hot weather.
